### 2. Matters arising.

- School wrap around care Mabel to chase up Aberdeenshire Council. If no luck with the council, there is the possibility of exploring a private avenue.
- Football coaching Sarah C. has been in touch with RGU but has not received a
  response. There was a suggestion that Judy M. in her new role may be able to help us
  source a coach. Karen has let Active Schools know which clubs we are interested in, so
  also hoping to hear back from them.

# 3. Chairperson/Treasurer's report.

- Three committee members are required to continue the PC. Mabel will stay on as Treasurer and is happy to Co-Chair. Alan has been acting Co-Chair since the AGM but now wishes to pass on the role. Darryl volunteered to take on Co-Chair. Proposed by Alan, seconded by Emily. Thanks to Alan for all his work and Darryl for volunteering!
- Since the pandemic, the PC and school's aims have been to bring the community back together. Social events and fundraisers have been well attended and supported by a wide group of parents. Grant applications have raised a significant amount of money.
- Autumn Fair was a huge success many thanks to Sarah C. for driving this and to Karen for being willing to be soaked! There was a fantastic turnout and the final total raised was £1157.12.
- Halloween Disco was greatly enjoyed by the kids and raised £105 many thanks to volunteers Jen R., Shelly, Mangala, Gemma, Cameron and Alison for running the event.
- Although the Summer Fair has been a big fundraiser in previous years, it was felt
  that it was a lot of work and that most of the money was made through the raffle.
  This year we could hold a Summer Fair 'light' with less work focus on the aspects
  that are profitable with less work (e.g. hog roast) and fun for the kids (e.g.
  inflatables). Ardoe may be able to support/provide space/inflatables. A small
  committee will be put together after the Christmas holidays to organise this.
