	SD updated that the account was sitting just over £5000.67p.	
	Only items outstanding for payment are the P7 leaver's books.	
	MJ highlighted that we are due to pay the Insurance Liability renewal at the end of	
	July. Need to clarify details on this.	
4	Race Night	LM
	It was agreed that the event was a success and lots of fun and that it would be worth	
	booking in for next March. The event raised £1460.50 which was a boost to PTA	
	funds. Lynne to re book for next year.	
5	Rag Bags	NGW
	On Hold.	
6	Candy Floss Machine	LMK
	Process will be looked at and the PTA will take over the bookings and store the	
	machine within the School instead of going via School Secretary.	
	Machine currently being stored by Nicki Walton.	
7	Parent Involvement in SC & PTA Meeting	LMK
	During the SC / PTA meeting, Mrs Conn discusses school related issues which may be	
	specific to all or just some classes. In order to ensure the message is migrated to all	
	the parents / guardians in a timely manner, it is suggested / hoped that at least one	
	parent / guardian representative from each class year attends the SC & PTA meeting.	
	This is also seen as an ideal opportunity for the class representative to ask about the	
	school / class concerns or even ideas they may have.	
	Due to lack of current PTA activity it is hard to push on or promote the FB page. But	
	going forward this tool should be used more often.	
	Currently the PTA FB member page is outdated and needs to be trimmed to only	
	include parents / guardians of pupils in the school currently. This should be	
	completed in conjunction with Mrs Conn to ensure no-one is incorrectly removed.	

8	Summer Fete 23 rd May 2020	INFO
	This event was cancelled for this year due to the COVID crisis. Although it was	
	originally hoped that it could take place later in 2020, unfortunately it has become	
	clear that this cannot happen due to social distancing constraints etc. therefore it is	
	expected to return as usual in May 2021.	
9	Halloween Disco	LMK
	DJ is booked – "Touch of Magic" Caroline updated – she will pass Liam's contact	
	details on as he is happy to take cancellation up-to 1 week prior without a fee.	
	At this stage and its TBC, but it's highly unlikely the Halloween discos will be able to	
	go ahead due to the COVID -19 outbreak. It was discussed about virtual activities	
	and to speak with school about activities that may be able to take place – however	
	felt we were not able to make any decisions at this point in time.	
10	School Council – Update at Meeting 9 th June 2020 at 7pm	Mrs Conn
	Mrs Conn updated the meeting that the PEF (Pupil Equity Funding) for the school	
	year 2020/21 had been cut for the year compared to the 2019/20 budget which was	
	disappointing.	
	Mrs Conn ran through where Aberdeenshire Council were at in terms of the return	
	to school on August 11 th 2020. They are looking into a number of issues and hopes	
	to have updates on these before the end of term on Friday 3 rd July 2020.	
	Return to School – proposed 11 th August	
	At this stage – the following appears to be the case;	
	 Lots of work required in the school to get it ready for the return of pupils, 	
	 Class Bubbles – looking likely to be around 10 pupils per class, 	
	Based on this, potentially only have 1/3 of pupils attend school at any one	
	time,	
	School learning will be completed in conjunction with home learning,	
	 Options for the school and home learning schedules are still being reviewed, 	
	A combination of blended learning is expected to be case – ie, via classrooms	
	and pupils joining via electronic interaction from home,	
	Options of how the school learning will work are to be confirmed but will take	
	account siblings and existing friendships per class bubble where possible,	
	Aberdeenshire Council are to advise which online platform can be used	
	moving into the new academic year to assist with this concept of learning,	
	The curriculum will be focused on Health & Wellbeing,	
	Impact on school meals & travel to/from is still being discussed,	
	Children returning to school will be provided with resources and will NOT be	
	required to come to school with school bags or pencil cases. Only themselves	
	and a jacket, possibly a water bottle (that only the pupil can use),	
	There will be no mandatory wearing of the school uniform for pupils	
	returning to school,	
	Mrs Conn advised that there are many issues still to be resolved / finalised, however	
	once all things were confirmed it would be communicated out to all	
	parents/guardians.	
	School Uniform – incl Jumpers, Cardigan & Polo shirts The school are preparing to move to a week based company called 'School Ware	
	The school are proposing to move to a web based company called 'School Ware	
	Made Easy'. The company supply many schools in the area and provide free returns	
	and orders can be made through them at any point of the year. This should make	
	things much easier for families to obtain school uniform with some additional items	

	added. Mrs Conn will be issuing an update on this in due course and when ordering	
	of uniforms can commence.	
	However – as per point above, because of the undermined school schedule, the	
	wearing of a school uniform will not be mandatory for the start of the school year.	
	Mrs Conn will advise on this over the future weeks.
