#### Google Classroom

#### Dalguise School Trip

- P7 parents can access the hardship fund if required to help with payments. Also Parish Funds are being accessed for household goods required i.e. white goods etc. Abernessities charity is also being used for other requirements.

#### Literacy support

- the school is working from what is called a 'recovery curriculum' after covid and reading is the main focus throughout the school. Homework ethos is being reviewed and will be communicated in the New Year. For younger year groups (p1/2) weekly phonics being worked on will be sent home for parents to help with any additional support required.
