How Parents can help their child to support Big Writing

- Look for <u>Vocabulary WOW</u> Words in books or other media
- Encourage your child to use <u>Connectives</u> in their speech eg. so, then, but, because, with, however
- Encourage your child to use different <u>Openers</u> in their sentences eg. Silently the tiny mouse crept into the hole.
- Look for <u>Punctuation</u> in books, in the environment and other media

Have fun making up powerful sentences with your child.

Eg. The owl flew to the tree,

Can be uplevelled to:

Suddenly and silently the barn owl swooped towards the crooked old oak tree because the warm morning sun was rising in the blue sky.
